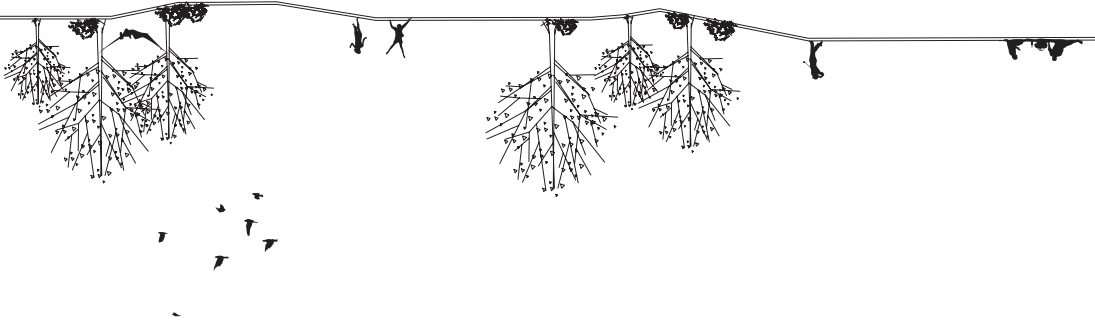

### LOCAL RULES - To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS:** Includes all ground beyond the Club's boundary. Rule 27 applies.  
**a) 18th HOLE:** The blue metal road and beyond on the right hand side is out of bounds.
- 2. RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES:** Balls entering residential properties are OOB and **must be abandoned**. Golfers must not enter residential (private) properties at any time. Disciplinary procedures apply.
- 3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** Relief may be taken from areas marked G.U.R. and/or defined with white markings or stakes. It may also include areas of unusual damage caused by ground staff and their equipment THROUGH THE GREEN. Rule 25-1 applies.
- 4. EMBEDDED BALL:** A ball embedded in its own pitch mark THROUGH THE GREEN may be lifted, cleaned and dropped without penalty, as near as possible to that spot no nearer the hole.
- 5. STAKED TREES:** If a staked tree or shrub under two club lengths in height interferes with a player's stance or the area of intended swing, the player MUST take relief as provided in Rule 24-2b(i).
- 6. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** All stakes defining hazards, environmental areas and G.U.R. areas are deemed to be "Immovable Obstructions". Rule 24-2 applies.
- 7. SPRINKLER HEADS:** All sprinkler heads, drainage grates and irrigation covers are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction, on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played, intervenes between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows:  
**a)** if the ball lie on the putting green, it may be lifted and placed, not nearer the hole, at the nearest point at which intervention by the obstruction is avoided.

**b)** if the ball lie off the putting green (but not in a hazard) and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped as in Clause (a) above.

- 8. PATHS:** All paths are to be treated as artificial surfaces and relief may be taken. Rule 24-2b(i) applies.
- 9. GARDENS:** Garden beds shall be treated as G.U.R. and relief MUST be taken. Rule 25-1 applies.
- 10. STONES IN BUNKERS:** Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.
- 11. EMBEDDED STONES:** May be treated as G.U.R.
- 12. ENVIRONMENTAL AREAS:**  
**a)** The area on the left hand side of the 15th fairway defined by the white stakes, and the areas behind the 7th green defined by the orange bunting fences are ground under repair from which play is prohibited and the player's ball **must be abandoned**. If a player's ball lies in either of these areas, or if they interfere with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 25-1.  
**b)** Environmentally sensitive areas are defined as, all areas of natural bushland within the golf course boundaries. Golfers please be aware that these areas are minimal impact zones. Therefore pull carts, and foot traffic to these areas should be of a minimum and will require you to be careful where you tread in the trees and cause as little damage as possible when playing your shot.
- 13. DISTANCE MARKERS:** 200 metre, 150 metre & 100 metre plates are placed in the middle of the fairways and are measured to the centre of the green.
- 14. STAKE IDENTIFICATION:** *White* - G.U.R. - *Red* - Lateral Water Hazard  
*Yellow* - Water Hazard - *White with Black tops* - O.O.B.

### RULES FOR THE PLAYING OF GOLF

- All players must report to the Pro Shop starter prior to commencement of play.
- Each player is required to have an individual set of clubs.
- Golfers and spectators alike must conform to the dress code.
- Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult in their golfing group in order to play the course or whilst utilising practice facilities.
- Play is restricted to groups of four golfers maximum, unless otherwise directed by golf pro shop personnel.
- Alcohol must not be brought to the resort for consumption on the golf course.
- All golfing groups regardless of number are required to hold their place in the field and keep pace with the group ahead. If directed by the Course Marshal to do so it may be necessary to play stableford or par and pick up, playing no further strokes on a given hole when unable to score in these formats.

### GOLF CART RULES

- Please refer to the 'Cart Rules' on the windscreen of the cart and the 'WARNING' notice on the dashboard for safe use of the cart.
- Golf carts must be driven with regard to personal safety and consideration of the golf course. Particular care should be taken when travelling downhill to avoid excessive speed.
- Care should be taken when driving uphill and downhill to avoid turf damage through braking and wheel spinning.
- On par three holes golf carts should remain on the pathway at all times.
- On approach to a green link to the pathway as soon as possible. Do not drive to the side of the green where no pathway exists.

All golf competitions at Forest Resort are governed by the rules of The Royal & Ancient Golf Club, St Andrews, Fife, Scotland.
